Preliminary archival and historical research indicates that the house was likely associated with Ichabod Wood Jr. who lived in the area from 1775- 1826, a time frame, which fits all of the recovered material. Ichabod Wood Jr. Is believed to have been a fairly typical farmer of the period and while he does appear in the historic documents regarding land transactions and such, does not appear to have been a prominent member of the Middleborough community of his time.
The cellarhole does have he unusual feature of possesing a hearh or hearth clean out in the cellar.
